STREAMLINING the mining approvals process is among the key recommendations the South Australian Chamber of Mines and Energy has made to the Leading Practice Mining Acts Review.

In September, Mineral Resources and Energy Minister Tom Koutsantonis announced the review of the Mines and

Works Inspection Act 1920, the Mining Act 1971 and the Opal Mining Act 1995.

Among its recommendations to the review, SACOME seeks streamlining of the mining lease approvals process to make them more workable for industry and transparent for stakeholders. It also recommends improving access to land to ensure the process is efficient and affordable for all parties.
